

HOW TO DRESS FOR THE SVA DRESS CODE

(Dress Code attire will be enforced from 7:30 am until the student departs from the school campus)

<p><u>SHIRTS</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Polo shirts, turtlenecks, or dress shirts that button-down all the way with a manufactured collar in any pattern or color <p><u>PANTS</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pants should be worn at the natural waist line (not dragging or touching the floor) <p><u>Grades 8-12 Banquet Attire</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ a sport coat, suit or tuxedo ✓ dress shirt and tie, ✓ dress socks and shoes <p><i>[You must be in compliance in order to gain admission to the event]</i></p>	<p><u>SHIRTS</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No sleeveless clothing • No printed slogans or inappropriate wording • Preschool & Grades K-5 are not required to tuck in shirts <p><u>PANTS</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Pants (no frayed/threadbare pants, athletic shorts/pants, sweats, jeans, or low riders) in any pattern or color • Walking Shorts that are no more than 2-3 inches from the knee in any pattern or color • Denim is allowed for Preschool & Grades K-5 <p><u>P.E. UNIFORM</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • P.E. uniform and gym shoes are to be worn during gym, weight class, & gymnastics for Grades 6-12 <p><u>SHEER AND/OR TIGHT-FITTING</u> clothing is not allowed</p> <p><u>SHOES</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Footwear must be worn at all times <p><u>HEAD WEAR</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Caps, hats, bandannas, or sweat bands are not allowed <p><u>JEWELRY</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No jewelry (other than medical bracelets) <p><u>HAIRSTYLES</u> (clean, well-groomed)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No outlandish hairstyles • Only natural color hair dye 	<p><u>SHIRTS</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Polo shirts, turtlenecks, or dress shirts that button-down all the way with a manufactured collar in any pattern or color • No cleavage, midriff, or underwear should be showing <p><u>PANTS</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Capris should be worn at the natural waist line (and not be excessively tight) in any pattern or color <p><u>SKIRTS, SKORTS, JUMPERS</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Skirts, skorts, or jumpers should not be more than 2-3 inches from the knee in any pattern or color • Material must be Spandex-free <p><u>DRESSES</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No dresses <p><u>Grades 9-12 Banquet Attire</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ no strapless attire ✓ no cleavage/underwear should be visible ✓ no sheer, tight-fitting or spandex material allowed ✓ back of gown must not fall below natural bra line ✓ dress should be dress code length or longer <p><i>[You must bring in your Banquet attire for approval and "photo shoot" used for admission to the event]</i></p>

SVA SWIMWEAR POLICY

Modest one piece, tankini where the shirt meets the bottoms, no string bottoms, or a bikini with a t-shirt over top (that is not white) and stays on the entire time

SVA WINTER WEAR POLICY

- ★ **Sweaters** (knit button-up or pullover) must have a collared shirt underneath which can be seen.
- ★ **Sweater turtlenecks** are permitted.
- ★ **Non-hooded or zip-up sweatshirts** must have a collared shirt underneath which can be seen.
- ★ **No heavy winter coats are to be worn in the classroom**
- ★ **SVA Spirit Wear May be worn on Friday** which includes SVA Integrity t-shirts or official spirit wear apparel in school colors (royal blue, light gold or white) which can be purchased through our Spirit Wear Provider.
